2024 Parent Questionnaire Feedback

- The percentage of returned questionnaires was 98% (34 handed out, 29 returned)
- Parents feel the important skills their children gain during their time at nursery, include: Confidence, independence, understanding, making friends, perseverance, more language
- Parents say the top favourite activities their children enjoy are: role-play, cookery, art and craft, play and exploring, outdoor play, climbing, storytelling, songs and music, building and construction and being the helper.
- 100% of families find staff approachable, helpful and well informed.
- 100% of families felt their priorities were met for their children; having fun, learning, gaining independence, making friends and a stable and experience staff team.
- 73% of families feel the setting is *very effective* at involving families in their child's early years experience. With 27% of families feeling the setting is *effective* at involving families in their child's learning.
- 73% of families found home visits *very beneficial* and 27% found them *beneficial*.
- 27 families are aware of the nursery blog. I was unaware of it and one was unsure.
- Families were asked how they would like us to share their child's progression and development; 73% (25) like our current learning journal (paper) with 13.5% preferring a digital format and 13.5% unsure
